THE HANOVER CENTER FOR TRADES AND TECHNOLOGY

The Hanover Center for Trades and Technology is a 46,000 square foot facility that was recently completed by Simmons, Rockecharlie, and Prince. The facility contains Wood working, Automotive, Electrical, Cosmetology, Culinary, and Computer Labs. The large industrial labs are heated with high efficiency condensing gas furnaces and ventilated with roof mounted fans in the summer. The adjoining classrooms are heated and cooled by a variable air volume terminal reheat system. Two 1400 MBH Condensing Pulse boilers provided hot water for space heating and an air cooled chiller provides chilled water for cooling. The new building is fully sprinkled and includes DDC controls, day lighting, occupancy sensor controlled lighting, and a 1600 amp, 480 volt electrical service.
