SEACOBECK HALL AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARY WASHINGTON

Seacobeck Hall on the campus of the University of Mary Washington, located in Fredericksburg, Va., is currently being renovated to replace the existing Kitchen including all associated mechanical, electrical, and plumbing work. The 46,000 square foot building consist of a basement cold and dry food storage area, two story dining halls and Kitchen, and student offices located in the basement level. The four dining halls served by the kitchen are also receiving new mechanical, electrical, and plumbing. A sprinkler system is being installed to protect the entire facility. The new mechanical system includes a new grease trap, new air handlers, new multi-stage condensing units and new steam to hot water convertors for heating.
